Hi All,

I am running some reports and am detecting not all districts have completed reviewing their reportable exit lists.

Specifically using the 'inactive records requiring archive' button to find records with an inactive reason in SIRAS that needs to be reported to CALPADS by archiving it.

Please see this page explaining next steps on finding the inactive records requiring archive predefined query.

Basically any of these that are found most likely need an archive created and then sent to CALPADS.

If you see that the inactive reason is already in CALPADS, then the inactive date in the SIRAS archive probably does not match the inactive date in SIRAS current data. That may or may not need to be investigated further. Reach out to support@sirassystems.com if you have any questions on any records you find.
